Key Message of the Week

We are committed to maintaining a high-quality, diverse workforce. We also have a significant number of vacancies to fill. If you know someone who would be a good asset to the NRC, let them know about the opportunities we have here.

What's Going on in NRR this Week?

In last week's edition, I mentioned that an agency-wide awards ceremony is being planned to recognize individuals who put in extra effort to support the agency's response to the events of September 11, 2001. The time and date for the ceremony has now been announced. It will be held on March 21 at 1:00 pm.

Maryland has become the second state to request a supply of potassium iodide (KI) pills. The other state to request KI pills is Massachusetts. Maryland requested 160,000 doses for its residents living near the Calvert Cliffs and Peach Bottom plants.

We have 77 vacancies in NRR. Twenty-three percent of these vacancies have yet to be posted. Sometimes it is difficult to find uninterrupted time here in the office to develop rating factors and/or review applications. That is why this type of work is a good candidate for project-based telecommuting. If you are in this situation, talk to your supervisor about available options.
