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FITNESS FOR DUTY SUMMARY

Management Actions

1. During the six-month period ending June 30, 2003, Monticello and Prairie Island conducted 1,307 drug and alcohol tests in accordance with 10 CFR Part 26. Monticello and Prairie Island workers subject to random drug and alcohol testing are assigned to one of three pools: Prairie Island, Monticello, and Corporate. Random test rates for each pool for the six-month period ending June 30, 2003, are as follows:

Corporate	59%
Monticello	55%
Prairie Island	56%
ALL	56%

For the semi-annual reporting period ending June 30, 2003, fourteen (14) workers were denied nuclear access after testing positive for drugs or alcohol. By test type: eleven (11) pre-access tests were positive, one (1) random test was positive and two (2) follow up tests were positive.

Pre-Access Positives

Four (4) licensee outage employees tested positive for marijuana, one (1) licensee outage employee tested positive for amphetamines, and one (1) licensee outage employee tested positive for alcohol.

Four (4) contractor employees tested positive for marijuana and one (1) contractor employee tested positive for alcohol.

The individuals listed above were denied access to NMC nuclear facilities.

Random Positives

One (1) licensee employee tested positive for alcohol.

The individual listed above was denied access to NMC nuclear facilities.

Follow Up Positives

Two (2) licensee employees tested positive for alcohol.

The individuals listed above were denied access to NMC nuclear facilities.

- 2. For the semi-annual period referenced herein all blind specimens submitted to Monticello and Prairie Island's HHS-certified laboratory yielded expected results.
- 3. NMC has analyzed program performance data for the six-month period ending June 30, 2003, and has revised existing Fitness For Duty procedures to incorporate enhancements as indicated by the analysis.
- 4. Monticello and Prairie Island continue to test for marijuana metabolites using an initial cutoff level of 50 ng/ml. This change was initiated on September 1, 1994, and communicated to the NRC by letter dated September 22, 1994.
 - 1,307 drug tests were performed for the six-month period ended June 30, 2003, under the lower initial cut-off level for marijuana as discussed above. A breakdown by worker type and quantification of the marijuana positives for the reporting period are as follows:
