The process of incorporating the NRC and Sandia review comments on the Probability Techniques Report was started. All of the remaining letters requesting permission from the appropriate publishers to use copyrighted figures and tables were sent out. Repsonses have been received for approximately half of the requests.

For the geochemistry chapter (Chapter 10) of the Probability Techniques Report, sections were completed on (1) the treatment and uses of statistical techniques to characterize the geochemical properties of aquifers, (2) a summary of techniques to assign probability distributions to empirical sorption data, and (3) a summary of probabilistic models of radionuclide release from the waste package (source term). This chapter will be completed by the end of July. The report is expected to be completed by the end of August.
