Activities and Accomplishments

The draft Generic Technical Position on design information needs in the Site Characterization Plan was reviewed per NRC's request. A copy of the review was forwarded to Mr. Tiktinsky of NRC.

In preparation for the EA Review meeting in Silver Spring in January, 1985, preliminary reviews of selected portions of the salt and basalt EA's were performed.

Discussions on the task description of proposed new activities for FY85 among SNLA staff and with the NRC program monitors continued during December. An earlier version that briefly discussed these tasks has been revised and forwarded to the NRC. The revisions consisted of expanded descriptions of the activities proposed and deliverables.

It is expected that during January, 1985 most of the effort will be in EA reviews at SNLA and at meetings at NRC in Silver Spring.
