SUBJECT Geology Appendix 7 interaction with NNWSI Contractor (USGS)

SUMMARY
Ralph Stein was concerned about the Geology App. 7 interaction scheduled for Aug. 26+27 in Denver (USGS). He had four chief concerns: 1. It seemed to him like a technical meeting; 2. The State wasn't involved; 3. The DOE would not benefit from it; 4. The subject matter (detachment faults) was too new for to be the subject of an interaction. The various NRC staff members (inc. Paul Prestholt, On-site Rep on his Las Vegas phone) responded as follows: 1. It is not a meeting — no positions are taken; the NRC will not be critiquing the NNWSI activities; it is an information-gathering exercise. 2. The NRC doesn't care if the states attend App. 7's (Prestholt). 3. DOE gets the benefit at technical meetings, which can be used for focusing on and progressing toward resolution of issues because the information exchange that traditionally blows down meetings will be accomplished in the App. 7's. The App. 7 helps to ferret out + sharpen the issues needing resolution via dialogue. 4. Detachment faults are not startlingly new — they were brought up as an issue at the June 12 NNWSI/NRC management meeting. Furthermore, there is much more to the interaction than just detachment faulting. Charla Abrams ran through the list of items that she + Keith McCord + Bush Abraham were interested in.
Ralph Stein was satisfied that the App. 7 should take place.
