

Subject: NRC Study

Mr. Richard Lee of NRC indicates that the Interagency Agreement has been finalized and we should have it shortly. The Friday, March 22 meeting is on schedule, and we should make reservations to attend. Tentatively, we will be briefed on NRC activities, background for study, regulations, and expectations on Friday A.M., and develop our study response-outline in the early afternoon, with adjournment in time to make Friday afternoon flights. It may not only be convenient, but necessary to stay in the Silver Spring area Thursday night to insure a early start on Friday morning.
