Meeting Summary -- Information Systems 8/31/84

SUMMARY

I explained to Vieth that contrary to the impression conveyed in his Sept. 14 letter to Bennett (that NRC was requesting that DOE implement an expensive ^{and information} issue management system, the purpose of the 8/31 meeting was to allow NRC to describe its plans for its own system, to describe why it considers the system to be needed, and to get feedback and suggestions from DOE.

I also elaborated on a point that seemed to have resulted in some misunderstanding; i.e. the standing of an issue management system in the licensing process. I explained that whatever issue tracking systems either agency might develop ^{with} whatever consensus ^{systems} ~~would~~ remain ^{only} tools for assuring that the information needed to allow assessments to be made against the criteria of 10 CFR 60 was being collected. In the final analysis, determination as to what points were or were not at issue would be determined through the hearing process.
