During the month of September, Weston had general discussions concerning present activities and potential reviews.

Work on Task Order 13, Subtask 2. Modification of the Draft Report "Survey of Geophysical Techniques for Site Characterization in Basalt, Salt, and Tuff" is in progress and although the material reviewed was more extensive than anticipated, the draft report is expected to be submitted mid to late October 1986. A letter will be submitted requesting additional funds.

Outstanding work on Task Order 16, Review of FEA's was completed in mid September. We will request a transfer of funds from a previous Task Order which has a balance remaining since the cost ceiling was not exceeded.
