During the month of August, Weston had general discussions concerning present activities and potential reviews.

Work on Task Order 13, Subtask 2. Modification of the Draft Report "Survey of Geophysical Techniques for Site Characterization in Basalt, Salt, and Tuff" is in progress and the draft report is expected to be submitted about October 15, 1986. A letter will be submitted requesting additional funds.

Outstanding work on Task Order 16, Review of FEA's is anticipated to be completed by mid September at which time we will request a transfer of funds from a previous Task Order which has a balance remaining since the cost ceiling was not exceeded.
