I have reviewed your monthly progress report for September dated October 14, 1986. This report describes the status of Nuclear Waste Consultant Technical Assistance under Contract No. NRC-02-85-009. Progress made to date under this contract is satisfactory.

As I have indicated to you in our telephone conversations we are having a meeting here in Maryland from November 4 through November 7. The first two days will focus on uncertainty in groundwater flow and planning for topical reports on the subject. The second two days will focus on preparing for the upcoming BWIP data review. I will lay out the details of our FY87 activities during the first session. As discussed previously, the first session will be held at the Sheraton Potomac in Rockville and the second session here in Silver Spring.

In response to your monthly report, we will have ample opportunity to modify NWC's contract to implement the appropriate "optional" SCP review task prior to initiating any such review. Clearly, an SCP will not just show up in the mail overnight. As you will be made aware next week, our FY87 priorities are in the areas of generic activities although for planning purposes we will assume one SCP arriving sometime later in the fiscal year.

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The action taken by this letter is considered to be within the scope of the current Contract NRC-02-85-009. No changes to cost or delivery of contracted services and products are authorized. Please notify me immediately if you believe that this letter would result in changes to cost or delivery of contracted products.
