Dear Dr. Cranwell:

I have received and reviewed your April monthly progress report for project A1158, dated May 15, 1986. The work performed during April has been fully satisfactory.

On May 23 I received the final draft of the TOUGH User's Guide, prepared by Karsten Pruess of Lawrence Berkeley Laboratory. Over the next two weeks this document will be reviewed by both RES and Geotechnical Branch staff members, and a package of review comments will be forwarded to you prior to July 4.

Through discussions with Ginger Wilkinson, a new timeframe has been arranged for the SWIFT II Technology Transfer Seminar. The tentative dates for this seminar will be August 19-22, the last day being an optional day as needed. It is planned that most or all of the attendees will have acquired INEL access parameters by that time, enabling them to interactively work with the sample problem set established for the SWIFT II code.

Ginger Wilkinson notified me this week that, in addition to the SWIFT II code, standardized versions of both NWFT/DVM and Generalized DVM have been transferred to and implemented at INEL under the code maintenance task. I was pleased to receive this notification, and wish to further commend the extensive work performed by the participating Sandia staff members in performing this transfer of codes to the INEL facility.

Thank you for providing an estimated date (September 1) for the transfer of the USGS 3-D code (Posson version) to the INEL system. Please keep me informed of any difficulties you may encounter in obtaining a standardized version of the code. As a reminder, you should request that a letter of transmittal accompany the magnetic tape or diskette that contains the code, along with an original copy of the relevant USGS user's manual.

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The action taken by this letter is considered to be within the scope of the current contract A1158. No changes to cost or delivery of contracted services and products are authorized. Please notify me immediately if you believe that this letter would result in changes to cost or delivery of contracted services and products for project A1158.
