As I discussed with you in a telephone conversation today, Mr. Tim Steele of In Situ has requested that Dr. Catherine Kraeger-Rovey of Terra Therma provide technical assistance to In Situ on their research contract for the NRC. NWC considers that this work would not produce a corporate conflict of interest with respect to Terra Therma's technical assistance to the staff under Contract NRC-85-009, since the In Situ work is also being performed for the NRC Staff. As you will note in my letter to Dr. Kraeger-Rovey, it is the policy of Nuclear Waste Consultants that Dr. Kraeger-Rovey will not be used in any capacity to review any In Situ work, should the NRC's Waste Management Staff task us to do so at some time in the future.

Dear Dr. Kraeger-Rovey:


You telephoned me today to discuss an offer that you have received from In Situ, Inc. to provide technical assistance under their current research contract with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. As you described the contract from In Situ to me, you anticipate that the work to be conducted for In Situ would comprise data reduction from their field experiments. I have discussed the situation with Mr. Galloway, Terra Therma's BWIP Team Manager under our contract with the NRC's Division of Waste Management and with Mr. J. Pohle, the NRC Project Officer. NWC considers that this arrangement would not produce a corporate conflict of interest, as described in your personal services contract with NWC, because both projects are being conducted for the NRC. Mr. Pohle concurs with this assessment.

Therefore, NWC approves of your participation in the In Situ project, subject to the following conditions and understandings:

- o You will provide to NWC a written description of the scope of work for In Situ within ten days of initiating work for them. If there are changes to that scope of work, you will notify the NWC Project Manager of the changes before agreeing to perform the new work. Because of Terra Therma's prior contractual commitments to NWC, the NWC Project Manager reserves the right to limit the scope of services that you may provide to In Situ solely in order to prevent conflicts of interest between the two contracts.
- o You recognize and acknowledge to NWC that you will not be eligible to review any In Situ work under Terra Therma's subcontract to NWC, should the NRC's Waste Management Staff request that such a review be conducted.
