This letter serves as the Nuclear Waste Consultants (NWC) trip report for the NRC Staff/Contractor review meeting in Silver Spring, Maryland, January 28-29, 1987. Nuclear Waste Consultants was represented by Messrs. Adrian Brown and Mark Logsdon. Because the bulk of the meeting was concerned with aspects of technical concerns at the Hanford site, NWC considers that this meeting is accountable under Subtask 2.3 of the current contract.

The initial purpose of the meeting was to review the NWC data needs assessment reports and to plan program activities for the balance of FY 87 and for FY 88. Discussions on this topic were held on both days. In addition, pursuant to a request from Mr. R.E. Browning, Director - Division of Waste Management, NWC and NRC Staff and Management engaged in lengthy discussions of NWC's re-review of the BWIP GWTT paper (ref.: NWC Communication No. 129) and the Staff's position on GWTT at Hanford. NWC assisted in the formulation of draft Questions and Answers to hypothetical concerns on the Hanford GWTT issue.


