I. For the Director, OCRWM

QACG Meeting with States and Tribes

On April 23, 1987, the meeting was held. The original issued agenda was revised to focus on discussion of the major issues associated with "State and Tribe Observer Participation in Program Audits." Consensus agreement was reached on all the major issues. A draft HQ-OGR policy will be drafted based on the agreements reached, which will be forwarded to the affected States and Tribes for review and comment. A status report on program activities was also presented by the NRC and each of the Project Offices.

Relations with the State and Tribal representatives were quite good and a spirit of openess and cooperation characterized the meeting.

- II. For the Associate Director, OGR
 - A. The QACG held their quarterly meeting in Germantown, Maryland on April 22-23, 1987. The major topics discussed during the executive session on April 22 were:
 - 1. NRC/DOE meeting results on "NRC Mini-Audits" policy and scope.
 - 2. HQ-DOE policy on interface with NRC and ES&H on project QA program submittals and approvals.
 - 3. Role of operations office management assessments and audits in satisfying OGR QA Plan requirements.
 - 4. Update on draft HQ-OGR QA Plan Supplements on "Issuing Stop Work Orders", "Readiness Reviews", and "Auditing for Effectiveness."
 - 5. Discussion of program requirements for "Consolidated/Common Training" and "Computer Software Control."
 - 6. QA requirements for "High-Level Nuclear Waste Production."
 - 7. Non-DOE observers participation in program audits.

 - A. Major activities completed this week:
 - 1. The memo to RW-30 regarding HQ/OGR endorsement of the proposed OCRWM Software QA Program is in the final approval/concurrence stage.
 - 2. The memo to QACG members regarding the response to HQ/OGR QA Assigned Action Items from the January 1987 QACG Executive Session was sent to the QACG members.
 - 3. WESTON delivered the multi-discipline review comments to the BWIP Safety Plan on 4/22/87 for HQ-OGR review.
 - 4. WESTON delivered the draft QIP 2.2, "Assignment of Quality Activity Levels", on 4/20/87 for HQ-OGR baselining.
 - 5. Lib Ibe of WESTON participated in the SRPO QA Audit of United Nuclear Corp. on April 21-24, 1987. No report on results as yet.
 - 6. Carl Newton completed the abstract for his paper, "Overview of National Waste Program" which is to be presented at the September, 1987 ASQC meeting.

 - 5. Draft QIP 16.2, "Stop Work" is in progress at WESTON.
 - 6. The QACG Meeting Minutes are being prepared by the QACG Secretary; issuance by May 6, 1987 is anticipated.
 - 7. Carl Newton is preparing a proposed "OGR Policy for Non-DOE Observers on DOE Audits" for review by State and Tribal representatives. The paper will reflect the agreements reached at the April 23, 1987, meeting with the States and Tribes.
