Attached is a copy of the form "Record of Correspondence Concurrence and Distribution" that the QA Branch has been using this past year. Charles Head of our division originated the idea for this form and it has proven extremely useful to the QA Branch. Two versions of this form are used by the QA Branch, one by Karl Sommer and one by Carl Newton. Our Secretary, Marie Adams has both forms stored on her computer under the file names KS and CN respectively.

The purpose this form serves for us are many; first, to specify and document the concurrences for issuance of the memo or letter. The exact concurrence list is specified by the originator and any needed changes to the base form (KS or CN) made by the secretary.

Another useful purpose this form serves is to allow the originator of the correspondence to specify the exact file name to be used on the computer for the correspondence so that if the secretary who originally typed the memo or letter is not available the item can be quickly found by someone else. We number ours consecutively (KS1, KS2, ... etc. and CN1, CN2, ... etc) and each originator keeps a log showing the designation, from, to, and subject. The designation, or file name on the computer, is entered by the Secretary in the area after the words "PC Code".

Another useful purpose the form serves is to identify the distribution to be made of the correspondence. We have a "basic" distribution we generally make and this makes respecifying it for each memo or letter unnecessary and helps assure we don't forget anyone. The originator is, of course, free to make any changes to the basic distribution. The form also allows the secretary to quickly count up the number of copies that need to be made after the correspondence has been signed and dated.

We in the QA Branch have found the form useful and would encourage others to use the idea if they feel it would help.
