Please publish RG 1.78, "Evaluating the Habitability of a Nuclear Power Plant Control Room During a Postulated Hazardous Chemical Release." This document has been reviewed by RES staff against: 1) the draft criteria, presently at the Commission for approval, for discretionary release of information to the public, and 2) factors for staff consideration provided by the EDO in a memorandum dated December 5, 2001. Based on this sensitivity review it has been determined that the content of RG 1.78 is benign and contains no sensitive information that can be misused by those with malevolent intentions toward NRC-regulated facilities and activities. The results of the review have been approved by Thomas King, the cognizant RES Division Director.

Publication of Revision 1 to Regulatory Guide 1.78, "Evaluating the Habitability of a Nuclear power Plant Control Room During a Postulated Hazardous Chemical Release," has been halted because of new Commission criteria for release of information to the public. I have reviewed the document against the Commission's draft criteria and guidelines in EDO's memo dated December 5, 2001, and have determined that the content of the report is benign and contains no sensitive information that can be used to support malevolent activities. The regulatory guide does not contain information covered by the Commission draft criteria. Specifically,

1. There is no plant specific information in the guide that might be used to exploit plant specific and site specific features including equipment and facility locations.
2. No specific facility location or site location is mentioned in the guide.
3. There is no information in the guide on physical barriers, vulnerabilities, or potential weaknesses relative to a plant site.
4. There is no information in the guide regarding construction details of facilities.
5. No information on defeat or breach of barriers with regard to a plant or site is mentioned in the guide.
6. No information on quantities of radioactive materials, present or authorized, is mentioned in the guide.

Please forward this information to Gill Millman with your recommendation that the regulatory guide be published.
