Bill--

Based on a conversation with Tom Smith, currently head of the PDR, the response to Question 12 needs to be revised as follows to be accurate.

Answer: We no longer have any formal relationship with local libraries regarding storage of our material, but we will be contacting the Government Printing Office to provide guidance to libraries on removal of certain material from public access. Some libraries have already removed material voluntarily.

The response to question 11 is not completely accurate either. All material removed from our web has NOT been removed from ADAMS. An example is our old press releases. These were removed from the web and then only those from August 2001 have been restored to the web. At no time were press releases removed from ADAMS and I'm certain they continue to be in ADAMS. I've asked Wayne Davis to verify this information.

A few questions that I thought I might bring up this afternoon include:

How have the events of 9/11 impacted the NRC?

Have you requested the FAA to institute a no-fly zone over nuclear power plants? Do you believe there should be a no-fly zone?

Isn't the Federal government responsible for defending against enemies of the State? If so, have you recommended stationing Federal troops at nuclear power plants to augment licensee security measures?

Why did NRC pull its entire website down when no other agency has taken that radical action?

Why did NRC wait so long to pull information/documents from the public domain?

Has the elimination of information on NRC's web impacted NRC's ability to carry out its business?
