Dear Mr. Chairman:

Periodically during the past couple of years, the Commission has been briefed by DOE Office of Civilian Radioactive Waste Management director Ben Rusche about the status of the high-level waste disposal program. We are writing to request that a representative of the Yakima Indian Nation be given the opportunity to address the Commissioners with our views on this subject when next such a briefing takes place. While we have not polled them on the subject, we feel certain that other affected Indian tribes, states, and citizens' organizations would also appreciate such an opportunity.

As you may be aware, the program is in a state of relative turmoil at this time. The Commission would not get an accurate reading on the state of the program if it were to continue to hear the perspective only of DOE, which remains unrealistically optimistic. At several times during the implementation of the Nuclear Waste Policy Act, the Commission has found it valuable to hear the views of the other affected parties informally in the context of a public meeting. We feel that the Commission would do itself a disservice were it to fail to solicit those other views now.

We urge you to act favorably on this request, and solicit the views of affected parties other than DOE when next you are briefed on the status of the nuclear waste disposal program.
