TRAINING COURSE LIST FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004 (STP-03-076)

Please complete the application form for each person attending a course and submit it to the Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP), ATTN: Brenda Usilton. Applications may be submitted at any time; however, applications should be received by STP a minimum of at least eight (8) weeks prior to the beginning of the course. The decision to hold or cancel the course will be made at that time. Applications received after the eight week deadline will be considered if there is a cancellation by one of the students selected. This will be the case for paying applicants as well as space available applicants.

As dates for these courses are established, we will post them under the "What's New" area on our Home Page. Other changes to the course schedule will also be noted on the "What's New" area of the Home Page.
