As of September 24th, the following meetings in the waste management program have been scheduled:

- NRC staff plan to attend a DOE/state/tribal meeting on October 3 and 4 in Atlanta, Georgia. This meeting is being held to discuss major pending issues in the HLW program, including the mission plan, the proposal to incorporate defense waste in the civilian repository, DOE's policy on liability and the Price-Anderson Act, and the status of the environmental assessments for the first repository sites.

In conjunction with the above meeting, NRC will attend a DOE/crystalline state meeting on October 3 to discuss the Region-to-Area Screening Methodology Document.
