Dear Ms. Foremaster:

I am writing in response to your February 13, 1992 letter which requested U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) information to support the establishment of a public reading room in Caliente, including an NRC contact who could support a speaker's bureau. You indicated the purpose of the reading room is to provide residents of Caliente the opportunity to review information regarding the proposed nuclear waste repository at Yucca Mountain, Nevada.

Since receipt of your letter, we have talked on several occasions to clarify the type of information you already possess as a result of our past meetings and through automatic distribution of NRC's high-level waste mailings. Based on those discussions, I am enclosing a list of supplemental NRC documents for your perusal. You may also want to contact the League of Women Voters Education Fund who, in 1985, authored "The Nuclear Waste Primer, A Handbook for Citizens." This Primer offered a balanced presentation on the facts surrounding the handling and disposal of radioactive waste and the League may have updated it since then.

As we have also discussed, you may add Mr. Paul Prestholt, NRC's On-Site Licensing Representative to the Speaker's Bureau listing. Mr. Prestholt is located at 301 East Stewart Avenue, #203, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101, and his phone number is 702/388-6125. Note that Mr. Philip S. Justus will replace Mr. Prestholt in late July or early August, 1992. We can also lend support from NRC headquarters should that be necessary. Please don't hesitate to let me know your needs.
