SUBJECT:	SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION POTENTIALLY RELEVANT AND MATERIAL TO PROCEEDING IN THE MATTER OF THE U.S. ARMY AND THE JEFFERSON PROVING GROUND SITE

In conformance with the Commission's policy on notification of the Presiding Officers and parties of new, relevant, and material information, this memorandum provides the information discussed below.

On September 22, 2003, the U.S. Army (the licensee) submitted a license amendment request for the Jefferson Proving Ground (JPG) site. The Army's license amendment request would create a 5-year renewable possession-only license. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted an acceptance review of the request and determined that the information provided was sufficient to begin the technical review (See Attached). NRC will publish a request for comments on the proposed license amendment and an opportunity for a hearing in the <u>Federal Register</u> (See Attached).

This information is being brought to the attention of the Presiding Officer, Special Assistant, and all parties, as it may be relevant and material to issues pending in the JPG proceeding.
