ALL AGREEMENT STATES, MINNESOTA, PENNSYLVANIA

FOLLOW-UP TO INFORMATION PRESENTED AT THE ORGANIZATION OF AGREEMENT STATES MEETING (STP- 03- 083)

During the meeting last week in Chicago, Illinois, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission announced a change to the criteria for identifying certain licensees as set out in the All Agreement States letter dated October 3, 2003. Specifically, in the first paragraph on the second page, the second sentence referring to sources larger than 0.001 of the quantity of concern is deleted. The paragraph should now read:

“For licensees authorized to possess an unlimited number of sources, please include those authorized to possess single sources larger than one-tenth of the quantity of concern. If you are uncertain whether or not a licensee of broad scope or a licensee authorized to possess an unlimited number of sources meets this criteria, please include them in the updated list.”
