Mr. Caldwell:

I am a resident of [REDACTED] in Cuyahoga County and the [REDACTED] in Lake County, Ohio. In Lake County, I own a house [REDACTED] Lake Erie so I have a very vested interest in writing to you to ask you to keep the Davis-Besse Nuclear reactor closed and to investigate and close the Perry Nuclear Power Plant.

The recent press citing the difficulties with unrecognized problems with both the Davis-Besse and Perry Nuclear Power Plants is cause for great concern. The blackout in the northeast signaled the unpreparedness of the Perry plant. Safety concerns brought on by terrorist activities during the past two years continues to increase those concerns for our safety and First Energy's lack of proactive management in protecting our health and our lives.

Mr. Caldwell, I have had [REDACTED] I cannot emphasize how unpleasant and long-term the effects are of even helpful radiation, let alone the imagined effects of doses caused by an "accident" or sheer carelessness at these nuclear power plants. I do not want to have to think about what may happen or that I may have to swallow little pills in the event there is a catastrophe. I do not want to consider that my backyard vegetable garden may have its soil contaminated for generations because of any fallout or unscrubbed, leaked radioactive debris. After Lake Erie has come back from its overpolluted death in the 1970s to a vibrant part of our lifestyle in the 2000s, I do not want to consider the irreversible damage to our lake, the interconnected Great Lakes and our water supply that an accident would cause.

NRC's top priority must be public safety. The physical attributes of the plants have fallen into admitted unrecognized disrepair. The plants location along Lake Erie and their very construction make them far too vulnerable to attack by plane or boat or simply "walk-ins" from security breaches. These realities indicate First Energy is putting their schedule and business management above concern for its Ohio and Canadian citizens and public lands, including our Great Lake Erie.

I do not want anyone's assurances of safety from existing plants because I believe there is no such thing as a safe nuclear power plant. History has proved this over and over. There are far too many opportunities for undetected "accidents."

In the best interests of protecting the land and lives God gave us, I urge you to keep Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Plant closed and to take necessary action against it and the Perry Nuclear Power Plant.


Dear Mr. Caldwell,

Thank you for taking the time to read our letter. We will keep it brief.


My wife and I live  minutes from Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Plant. Davis-Besse has had two near-disasters since 1985. In 1985, the NRC went to great lengths to assure that Davis-Besse would never come that close to disaster again. However, it did. In March 2002, an employee discovered a 5"x7" hole on the reactor. The acid had leaked through 6 inches of steel, leaving only 3/8" of a stainless steel to seal the reactor.

Our concern is that **public safety is top priority** and not First Energy's schedule. Some statistics from a 1982 study performed for the NRC follow. If a core meltdown were to occur at Davis-Besse it would cause over 10,000 thousand deaths due to exposure to radiation. In addition, it would also cause over 70,000 radiation related injuries. It would cause ~\$160 billion in damages to Davis-Besse alone, not including health care costs to the affected population, lost wages, relocation expenses, decontamination costs or lost property or farmland. Finally, an accident at Davis-Besse could destroy Lake Erie and potentially the Great Lakes system—the largest freshwater system in the world. Lake Erie provides drinking water to 11 million people. If Lake Erie were destroyed, Ohio tourism, fishing and agricultural industries would also suffer tremendously.

In considering the ecology, economy and health of Lake Erie region and the many lives at risk, my wife and I request that you keep Davis-Besse nuclear reactor closed.


Hello, my family and I are alarmed and concerned with information received of the Davis-Besse Nuclear Reactor. Ohio citizen action brought us the facts surrounding an action to close the plant down. We agree. My family consists of my Grandma, Aunt, Cousin, and myself when I am away from school in Arizona. We live in Strongsville, Ohio, a suburb of Cleveland. Also nearby are my cousins David, Robin, Dana, their children, my Uncle Russell, Uncle Donald, Aunt Shirley, my mom and dad, and my little brother. We share the same concerns. We are aware of the health risks of the Nuclear facility. We also know how difficult it is to harness the power of the atomic energy. Due to health, economic, and environmental reasons, we agree that the risks aren't worth the consequences.

Threats of meltdowns are apparent, and the maintenance of the facility costs too much in taxes for the people. Money should be the least of our worries. We live in a country that supplies less than 25% of the world's resources, but has 75% of the world's waste. We need power, but our culture is too apprehensive to try new energy efficient alternatives. The expense of Nuclear Power could be spent on more eco-friendly methods of power creation and conservation, such as wave, solar, and wind energies. These are ecologically correct methods of harnessing energy. They are expensive to research and develop, but the fuel necessary is cheap and abundant. 50 garage sized wave power facilities on the coast of California could supply the southwestern United States with power. One of these said facilities exists in the coast of Ireland, and it powers much of the country. Where are our alternatives? They exist in tax breaks for fuel efficient vehicles, but there are no choices publicly available for electricity.

What is important to us is our Health, and most importantly, the health of our children. Leukemia lurks in a 30 year distance of subjectivity to radioactive hazards. How many people have you known that have had cancer? On March 6th, the faculty at Davis-Besse found a 5 by 7 inch hole in the reactor. Three-eighths of an inch separated us from a meltdown. The negatives of Nuclear power exceed the positives. One meltdown means 10,000 cancer related deaths in the exposed population, 1,400 fatalities from radiation exposure other than cancer, and 73,000 injuries related to radiation, all in a 25 mile radius. Public safety is our number one priority, and what we are hoping to preserve with this action.

Environmentally we have to realize that humans may not exist much longer in geological time. What is to be left over to the next wave of planetary evolution? The great contaminated lakes, will be replacing the great lakes freshwater system, slowly destroying our current habitat and the biodiversity within.

We are acting on this to persuade the powers that be, to keep the Davis-Besse reactor closed. We seek immediate action to save our health, money, and environment. Please respond to our concerns, because this is your world as it is ours.
