Dear Ms. Bailey:

In August 1991, we sent the enclosed letter to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requesting termination of the subject two registrations. In August 1992, we sent a second letter, also enclosed; again we indicated we wanted the two registrations terminated. In March 1999, we sent a third letter, also enclosed; still again we indicated we wanted the two registrations terminated. After sending the 1999 letter, we followed up with a telephone call to make sure the letter had been received; the NRC acknowledged receiving it.


We have been billed periodically for the annual registration fees for the devices over the past 12 years, most recently in current NRC Invoices AM3703-2 and AM3903-2. Copies of these invoices are enclosed. We have not paid these fees in the past and will not pay them now, based on our requests for termination.

We again ask that the two registrations be terminated, and that all invoices for fees since 1991 be canceled and removed from our file. The two devices have been in our possession continuously since 1991 and have not been loaned to any other agency or private organization during that time. We have used the devices at our own facility on one or two occasions since 1991 under the terms of our NRC Byproduct Materials License No. 45-23090-01. That license allows us to use the sources and devices at our facility, regardless of registration status, for research and development activities.

We spoke to Mr. John Janovich of your office on August 25, 2003, and he recommended we write directly to you. We look forward to receiving a letter from the NRC indicating these registrations have been terminated, per this and our previous requests, and that all fee invoices have been

Dear Sirs:

Please terminate the subject registrations as of September 30, 1991, or earlier, as necessary in order to have the FY 1991 annual fee (of \$3100 per device) waived for these registrations. It is our understanding that we will no longer be able to transfer the devices covered by these registrations to other licensees for use in their programs, but that we can maintain the devices and sources for our own use under our materials license.

We do have two comments about the new fee program which we hope will be forwarded to the appropriate office at the NRC. First, the fees for annual registration seem to be quite out of line with any services provided. Once a device is registered (a service which is charged for separately, and at a considerably lower fee), as far as we can see the NRC has nothing further to do to maintain that registration except file it. What does the NRC do to justify an annual \$3100 charge per registration?

Second, the unreasonably high fees will have a stifling effect on small research and development efforts such as ours. Although one of the two devices covered by these registrations has been a substantial stimulus on commercial nuclear gauge manufacturing, the annual charge is leading us to end our technology transfer programs with these particular gauges. And it is likely to inhibit future R&D efforts. We suggest the NRC take another look at these fee schedules.

Dear Mr. Camper:

In August 1991, we sent the enclosed letter to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requesting termination of these two registrations. In August 1992, we sent a second letter, also enclosed; again we indicated we wanted the two registrations terminated. We have received invoices for the annual registration fees two or three times since then, but have not paid them based on our requests for termination.

We have recently been billed again (Invoice No. AM5427-98) and Ms. Sandra Kimberley of the NRC has informed us verbally that our request for registration termination was turned down in 1996. We were never informed of the latter action.

We again ask that the two registrations be terminated, and that all invoices for fees since 1991 be canceled and removed from our file.
