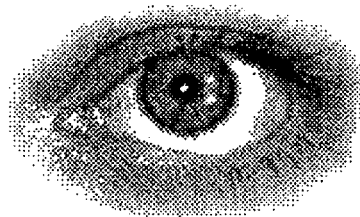


Mr. Jim Cauldwell,

Dear Mr. Caldwell:

I am writing to you to express my concern about the restart of the Davis-Besse nuclear reactor. Davis-Besse remains the most dangerous nuclear plant in America. Nothing has been done to change this fact. In February 2002, it came closer to a nuclear meltdown than any U.S. plant since Three Mile Island. Investigators discovered the cause: years of management neglect for basic maintenance, lying to regulators, ignoring employees' warnings, and punishing employees who spoke out about these concerns. Fifteen months later, none of the top managers have been replaced, and the company's own investigation shows continued widespread intimidation of workers who uncover or disclose safety problems.

It is criminal negligence to subject the citizens of Ohio (and all of us who live in the prevailing effluent pathways to the East) to reactor "Russian roulette". This reactor should not be restarted until your agency has ordered, received back, and evaluated the report of an Independent Safety Assessment on the entire facility (as was done at the Maine Yankee Atomic Power Station).

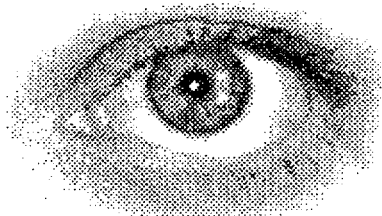
Your agency is supposed to be concerned with nuclear safety NOT promotion of nuclear power at any cost and at unknown risk. Your top priority--by congressional mandate and under federal law and regulation--is to keep Davis-Besse closed unless and until safe operation can be assured. The absolute assurance of public health and safety--not the scheduling convenience of First Energy--is the only matter your agency needs to address on the Davis-Besse restart issue.

An Ohio Citizen Action member has informed my wife and me that Davis-Besse, operated by First Energy, is seriously considering restarting a faulty nuclear reactor. I understand employees of Davis-Besse discovered serious damage on March 6, 2002, and the equipment failure potentially could have led to a meltdown of the reactor core.

As a [REDACTED] year employee of Rockwell International and E. G. & G. Inc. at the Rocky Flats Nuclear Weapons Plant (RFP) in Golden, Colorado, I believe I have the credibility to present an opinion about the Davis-Besse situation.


I began a career at RFP as a chemical operator. I specifically handled liquid and solid plutonium streams. The amount of training involved in plutonium processing was absolutely astonishing. I can't emphasize enough how safety conscious my co-workers and myself were required to be. Safety was the primary task of over 5,000 RFP employees. Workers would never think of intentionally performing an unsafe act.

Operating unsafe equipment is inordinately risky, and shows a complete disregard for public health and safety. Operational and safety procedures are specifically designed to prevent even the slightest possibility of equipment failure. Disregard of safety standards with a nuclear reactor is inconceivable.

It is fundamentally imperative that First Energy eliminates any potential equipment failure by performing the appropriate maintenance and modification of the reactor system before any thought goes into restarting a nuclear reactor. There is no excuse for dismissing safety and restarting a faulty reactor.

I implore you to do the right thing and prevent First Energy from carelessly operating unsafe equipment.
