NRC HAS ADDED A THIRD RESIDENT INSPECTOR AT DAVIS-BESSE NUCLEAR POWER STATION

Nuclear Regulatory Commission officials in Lisle, Illinois, have assigned Monica P. Salter-Williams as the third resident inspector at the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station in Oak Harbor, Ohio.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear power plant has at least two NRC resident inspectors. They serve as the agency's eyes and ears at the facility, conducting regular inspections, monitoring significant work activities and interacting with plant workers and the public. The NRC has added a third resident inspector to the NRC team at Davis-Besse as a result of the reactor vessel head degradation and the resulting need for increased NRC oversight.

Salter-Williams began her duties at the Davis-Besse plant in September. Prior to joining the NRC's Region I office in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania, as a reactor engineer in 2002, she worked as an engineer at the Three Mile Island Nuclear Power Station in Middletown, Pennsylvania.

Salter-Williams earned a bachelor of science degree in chemistry from Georgia State University in Atlanta, Georgia, and a master of science degree in nuclear engineering from Pennsylvania State University in University Park, Pennsylvania.
