In your letter dated June 25, 2003, you requested that the NRC staff provide you with the Total-system Performance Assessment (TPA) source code. This letter responds to that request.

As you know, the staff is currently developing the TPA code to assist in its review of a potential license application submitted by the U.S. Department of Energy for a repository at Yucca Mountain. In response to your request, by letter dated May 21, 2003, the staff provided you with ten copies of TPA Version 4.1j that included all files (including executable files, data files, and input files) required to run the code.

The staff is in the process of reviewing the TPA source code for public release. When our review is complete, it will be made available to you and other interested stakeholders via the Licensing Support Network (LSN).
