

Dear Sir or Madam:

In response to the events of September 11, 2001, Entergy (Entergy Operations, Inc., or Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc.), on its own and in response to NRC Advisories and Orders and industry initiatives, promptly initiated and has maintained heightened security measures to continue to provide high assurance that activities involving special nuclear material are not inimical to the common defense and security and do not constitute an unreasonable risk to the public health and safety in the current threat environment.

On April 29, 2003, the NRC issued three orders requiring additional compensatory measures as prudent to address the current security threat environment. In its response to Order EA-03-038 [Compensatory Measures Related to Fitness For Duty Enhancements Applicable to Nuclear Facility Security Force Personnel] dated June 3, 2003, Entergy stated "Entergy will immediately start implementation of the requirements in Attachment 2 to Order EA-03-038 and, subject to the relief requested and the possible request for a hearing, will be in compliance by October 29, 2003." In its July 24, 2003 letter, Entergy confirmed "Unless and until the NRC grants the requested rescission and/or relaxation, Entergy will continue to implement those portions of the Order on the schedule provided and will complete implementation of all provisions of the Order by October 29, 2003." Entergy has received an NRC letter dated October 23, 2003 addressing the requested relaxation. Pursuant to Condition III.C.2 of the Order and the requirements of 10 CFR § 50.4, this letter contains Entergy's response to Condition III.C.2.

As required by Condition III.C.2 of the Order, Entergy hereby notifies the Commission that full compliance with the requirements described in Attachment 2 of the Order has been achieved as of the date of this letter. Security staffing levels support the limits on work hours and required monitoring programs are in place to demonstrate continuing compliance.
