Subject: Supplement Information for License No. DPR-36 (Docket 50-309, ISFSI Docket 72-030) Request for Exemption from NRC Certificate of Compliance No. 1015, Amendment 2, Technical Specification B3.4.2.6

Gentlemen:

By letter (Reference 1), Maine Yankee submitted an exemption request to Technical Specification B3.4.2.6 of Certificate of Compliance No. 1015, Amendment 2. Maine Yankee inadvertently omitted reference to certain requirements in 10 CFR Part 72 that apply to the exemption request. This letter identifies the additional requirements in 10 CFR Part 72 that are subject to the exemption request.

This supplemental letter additionally requests USNRC approval of exemption request (Reference 1) to certain requirements in 10 CFR 72.212(a), 72.212(b)(2)(i), 72.212(b)(7), and 72.214. These regulations require, in part, compliance to the terms and conditions of the NAC-UMS® Certificate of Compliance, Reference (2). One of the conditions applied to the Certificate of Compliance requires fulfilling the requirements of the Technical Specifications, Reference (3), for the NAC-UMS® Universal Storage System. Reference 1 requested exemption to the Technical Specification.
