Dear Mr. Spackman:

Power Resources, Inc. (PRI) has been providing Corrective Action Reports on a monthly basis since a minor leak was determined at the West Evaporation pond on January 4, 2002. As recently discussed with Mr. Steve Ingle of the WDEQ-WQD and Mr. John Lusher, NRC Project Manager, use of the West Evaporation Pond was discontinued this past summer in order that it can be dried out, be emptied of sludge, and then repaired by installing a new liner.

The liner will not be installed until next summer after the sludge is removed. As discussed with Mr. Ingle and Mr. Lusher, PRI does not intend to use the West Evaporation Pond until it is repaired. Therefore, the pond will remain effectively dry. PRI will continue the routine monitoring of the leak detection system. It is planned to no longer submit any Corrective Action Reports unless conditions at the pond significantly change.
