RE: Pneumatic Pathways Technical Exchange July 31, 1995


Dear Mr. Austin:

I would like to express my appreciation for you making your staff available for the technical exchange on unsaturated zone pneumatic pathways on Monday, July 31, 1995. Although we continue to feel that the issues warranted a full day (at least) face-to-face meeting, we are nevertheless satisfied that given the time available the exchange was very successful.

Based on the information exchanged during the meeting, including your own closing remarks, as well as subsequent informal conversations with your staff and YMSCO personnel and its contractors on the Las Vegas end, we are confident that there is now an increased awareness of the importance of data acquisition in this area. This is particularly true with respect to timely, undisturbed gas chemistry data. We are now more confident that the DOE site characterization program in this area will be improved, resulting in improved understanding by all concerned of these important natural systems at Yucca Mountain.
