NRC ANNOUNCES THE AVAILABILITY OF LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR D.C. COOK NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 & 2

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission is announcing the public availability of an application for a 20-year renewal of the operating licenses for Units 1 and 2 at the D.C. Cook nuclear power plant. The NRC received the application from the Indiana Michigan Power Co. on November 3.

The D.C. Cook plant is located near Benton Harbor, Michigan. The current operating license for Unit 1 expires on October 25, 2014; the current operating license for Unit 2 expires on December 23, 2017.

The NRC staff is currently conducting an initial review of the application to determine whether it contains enough information for the required formal review. If the application has sufficient information, the NRC will formally "docket," or file, the application and will announce an opportunity to request a hearing.
