
Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), I am asking for information concerning Curtiss-Wright Corporation, which owned the Quehanna Nuclear Reactor Facility in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania from 1955 to 1960. Specifically, I am requesting the following materials:

1. (a) A copy of Byproduct Materials License No. 37-2416-2 issued to Curtiss-Wright Corporation for the above-referenced facility as well as copies of any other byproduct materials licenses issued to any party for operations conducted at the above-referenced facility;
- (b) A copy of Facility License No. R-36 issued to Curtiss-Wright Corporation for the above-referenced facility as well as copies of any other facility licenses issued to any party for operations conducted at the above-referenced facility;
- (c) Any source material or special nuclear material licenses relating to the facility; and
- (d) All applications submitted to obtain the above licenses.
2. Any reports, assessments, memoranda, letters, bills, invoices or other communications concerning any indemnification agreements relating to the above-referenced facility provided by the United States government pursuant to contract or the Price Anderson Act.
3. Any reports, memoranda, letters or other communications concerning radioactive waste disposal or residual radioactive contamination by or relating to Curtiss-Wright Corporation.
