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Gentlemen:

On April 29, 2003, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Order EA-03-038 (Reference 1) modifying the operating license for Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station to require compliance with the compensatory measures (CMs) related to fitness-for-duty enhancements applicable to nuclear facility security force personnel. On October 23, 2003, the NRC provided a letter to TXU Energy providing a revision 1 to the Discussion Enclosure in Reference 2, and provided a revision 1 to the CMs of the Order.

By this letter TXU Energy hereby answers the Order in accordance with Section III.C of the Order. TXU Energy has achieved full compliance with the requirements in Attachment 2 of the Order as modified and clarified by the NRC's letter of October 23, 2003 (Reference 3).
