Dear Chairman Zech:


I am writing to ask for your assessment of the effect that the recent House floor vote disapproving the measure that would have increased the pay of top executive and judicial branch employees will have on your agency.

It will be important, for further legislative action, for Members of Congress to understand the magnitude of the effect of the pay issue on the operation of the federal government. I would appreciate your views on how the pay issue is affecting your mission. I am particularly interested in the number of individuals affected, the effect of the pay gap on morale, the possibility that affected employees will leave federal service, and the potential recruitment problems that are presented.

Because I plan to introduce legislation by tomorrow at the latest, I would appreciate your timely response.
