
I am writing this letter in regards to the continuation of the closing of the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Plant.


Dear Mr. Caldwell,

I am writing to you since I understand that you have the authority to keep the Davis-Besse nuclear power plant closed.

I understand that in March 2002 there was an acid leak which ate through 1/2 foot of carbon steel leaving only 3/8 of an inch of stainless steel cladding to seal Davis-Besse's reactor. My thoughts on this is if such a hole could be repaired, it may become a stress area. Instead of a 5-by-7-inch hole on the reactor, a much more serious disaster could occur. Radiation-related injuries and fatalities are not worth reopening Davis-Besse. Furthermore, due to the location of Davis-Besse, a disaster would not only impact the citizens of Ohio, but also Pennsylvania and New York. Water from Lake Erie flows into Lake Ontario. Need I say more? I don't mean to come across as an alarmist, but I feel that our natural resource of water needs to be protected from any decisions made by FirstEnergy to adhere to their schedule of reopening the power plant. If our water supply is destroyed by a nuclear accident, then we too, will be doomed.

[REDACTED] is our home. We can see the cooling tower of Davis-Besse on the horizon in front of our house, and we are directly in the path of fallout from any future accident which might occur at that facility.

When the erosion of the protective dome was first announced, I felt non-threatened in that First Energy actually discovered the damage and was doing something about it. As the investigation unfolded, my fear level mounted. It was soon apparent that First Energy was not attentive to the safety issues of nuclear power. I soon came to believe that First Energy management cared more about their profits than the safety of their neighbors.

Considering the history of neglect at the Davis-Besse power plant, and the events of March of 2002, I live in fear for my children and grandchildren, as well as for everyone living in the Lake Erie watershed. I am no stranger to the nuclear industry; I have done much research. I, myself, am an engineer.

Too often our safety is compromised by the economic schedules of large power companies. It appears that common-sense and considerations for human life will have to be forced upon them. The power companies must know that they are fully accountable for possible disasters, perhaps not legally, but at least morally.

A small hydrogen bubble brought us near disaster at Three-Mile Island; capricious maneuvers by untrained politicians brought Chernobyl unspeakable horrors. Obviously, the margin of error for safety is infinitesimally small in these situations. I am not satisfied the changes at the Davis-Besse plant are severe enough to make us safe.

I, therefore, call upon the authorities involved to cease all operations at the Davis-Besse plant. It is the NRC's responsibility to close this plant down for the safety of us all. Please let me know, at the address below, how you will ensure our safety.


Please be advised that the recent troubling safety concerns at Davis-Besse have caused me to conclude that the reactor needs to be permanently closed down.






