I am responding to your correspondence dated June 3, 2003, by which Nuclear Fuel Services, Inc. submitted administrative changes to your Emergency Plan (Plan), reflecting updates to the facility based on recent construction and other minor updates. We have completed our review of the submitted changes, and have determined that these changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the Plan, and thus were properly submitted under the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(i).
