

NRC License Renewal Process

- ⌘ 40 year license authorized by AEC
- ⌘ First renewed license issued in 2000
- ⌘ About 1/3 of all licenses have been renewed or are under review
- ⌘ Environmental impact statement developed for each review
- ⌘ Timely consultation critical to schedule






