As I explained then, contrary to your assertions, I am advised that the evaluations now underway are not meetings of the type which, under existing meeting agreements and policies, would be conducted as public meetings. Moreover, despite your unwarranted characterizations of the nature of the ongoing efforts and the notice itself, it should be clear from the November 4th notice that to the extent that any changes to current policies, practices or protocols may be under consideration, it is with a view of accommodating public observation, not foreclosing it.
