

REVIEW MEETING FOR DC-24 EXPEDITED SPECIAL CASE

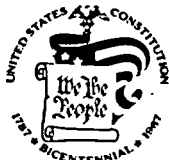
As you know, the Basalt Project has assembled documents describing and controlling work relating to drilling geohydrology monitoring facilities required in the Pre-Exploratory Shaft test program. Your technical representatives have been reviewing these documents so we might address technical questions prior to the start of drilling DC-24. I wish to thank you and your staff for this very important effort and for your cooperation.

On August 18, the Basalt Waste Isolation Division will conduct a closure workshop to discuss your comments and questions resulting from review of the package entitled Expedited Special Case Restart for Drilling DC-24, 25, 32, and 33 delivered to you during June 29-July 1. Written comments delivered to the Division Office by August 11 will be addressed in the meeting. We will attempt to address all comments received up and through the 18th and will have all appropriate technical individuals on call during the meeting. While attendance by your representative is not necessary in the event you have no questions on the package, it is our intention to facilitate a full discussion as necessary for any contentious items. Consistent with this intent, the workshop will be held under procedural control to ensure that all questions are addressed and fully documented. Please advise D. H.
