## **PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED LICENSE RENEWAL AND PUBLIC HEARING SCHEDULE**

### **SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL**

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) invites your participation in a proposed license renewal decision. DHEC is proposing the issuance of an amendment for license renewal on the continuing operation of the low-level radioactive waste disposal facility in Barnwell County, South Carolina to Chem-Nuclear Systems, LLC, Barnwell Waste Management Facility located at 740 Osborn Road, Barnwell, SC 29812. As part of this proposal, DHEC has prepared a draft Radioactive Material License 097, Amendment 49 under the South Carolina Radioactive Material Regulation 61-63 (Title A).

The State draft radioactive material license amendment contains conditions for the operation, monitoring and closure of the disposal facility. DHEC has made a preliminary determination that the proposed radioactive material license amendment will comply with applicable State and Federal regulations.

Copies of the draft radioactive material license amendment, draft technical evaluation report, and environmental radiological performance verification of the disposal facility are available for review during regular business hours, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays at the following locations:

To be considered, all requests and/or comments must be received in writing no later than December 31, 2003, at which time the forty-five (45) day public comment period will end.

A joint public hearing for the draft license is scheduled for December 11, 2003, at 7:00 p.m. The hearing will be held at the Peoples Auditorium, Simms Building, SC DHEC, 2600 Bull Street, Columbia, South Carolina. Any interested persons may participate in the public hearing by giving oral or written statements. Oral statements presented at the hearing should be limited to five (5) minutes. Written submission of the oral statement is required to be placed in the hearing record.
