

I. GENERAL STATUS

Discussed schedule for site reclamation with SWEC, and obtained revised schedule for field work in Louisiana and Mississippi.

Discussed with HQ and CH the BLM request to transfer management of two test wells in Utah from DOE to BLM.

Initiated preparation of PEB report for Parsons-Redpath's award fee for the 10th period.

Authorized ONWI participation in NNWSI ESF 50% design review.

Met with ONWI to discuss status of closeout tasks and staff reduction.

Transmitted to HQ for review the revised Activity Plan for site reclamation in Utah.

Discussed with NNWSI the transfer of equipment needed to support the ESF 50% design review.

Met with ONWI staff to evaluate technical value of two (2) Fluor and one (1) SWEC reports to other users and decisions were made concerning distribution of all unpublished reports.

Reviewed revised Activity Plan for the plugging and abandonment of wells in the Paradox Basin of Utah. This plan adequately addressed the comments to the first draft of the plan.

Met with Danny Smith of the Texas Nuclear Waste Programs Office to discuss the status of their closeout activities, records turnover, and the final disposition of equipment acquired with grant funds.


Arranged opportunity for employees to view a videotape on fusion energy prepared by the Chicago Operations Office.
