I. GENERAL STATUS

SRPO and CH held a termination conference with Battelle in Hereford.

SRPO approved a right-of-entry agreement for SWEC, which will be used in negotiating access to test sites in Louisiana.

SRPO conducted a field inspection of site reclamation activities in Utah. ONWI concluded its field inspection of these activities.

SRPO, with the participation of the Mississippi Energy and Transportation Department, scheduled a meeting on site reclamation activities with Mississippi regulatory agencies, other interested agencies, and the National Guard Department. The meeting will be attended by SRPO, SWEC, and ONWI, and is scheduled for June 30, 1988 in Jackson.

SRPO discussed with the Bureau of Land Management the transfer of wells at two (2) test sites in Utah to the BLM.

SRPO initiated an analysis of relative costs for alternative schedules and locations for disposition of Government property currently in Hereford.

SRPO reviewed the termination settlement proposal which was submitted by Fluor. SRPO began a review of proposed costs associated with post-termination activities by P-R.

Transferred Fluor, Parsons-Brinckerhoff, Battelle, TBEG contracts; and Texas, Utah, Mississippi and Louisiana grants to Chicago Operations Office. Other miscellaneous non-active contracts also transferred.
