The following are my comments on the subject periodic report:

1. On page 29 of the report, under "Program Structure", it is reported that for further evaluations/enhancement of the CONVO Code, a plan was set to temporarily replace the input and output programs which were written in BASIC by simplified FORTRAN routines. The decision to use BASIC for input/output was to facilitate real time machine/user interaction in the analysis. I have no objection to the use of FORTRAN for input/output in CONVO if the change is only temporary and to facilitate evaluation. Any permanent change must be based on whether such change will improve machine/user interaction.
2. On page 29, under "Program Enhancement Areas", Figure A is not provided in the report as it should be.
