NOTICE OF UPCOMING MEETINGS

As of May 21th, the following meetings in the waste management program have been scheduled:

- On May 20-21, from 8 am to 6 pm, in Albuquerque, New Mexico, NRC and DOE will sponsor a Symposium on Groundwater Flow & Transport Modeling for Performance Assessment of Deep Geologic Disposal of Radioactive Waste. The purpose of the symposium is to provide an opportunity to exchange ideas on current and developing performance assessment approaches in the fields of groundwater flow and transport modeling, associated with the geologic disposal of radioactive waste. The symposium will be composed of both invited and contributed papers. Participation will be limited to approximately 100 persons, consisting of HYDROCOIN participants and their invitees; a limited number of observers will be admitted as space allows. - On May 22-23 at 8 am, there will be a BWIP Hydrology Workshop meeting with NRC and DOE to discuss BWIP's hydrologic baseline evaluation and changes in hydrologic testing strategy.
