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## NOTICE OF UPCOMING MEETINGS

As of May 3rd, the following meetings in the waste management program have been scheduled:

- On May 9th, at 9 a.m., there will be a technical information exchange between an NRC Research contractor (Battelle Columbia Laboratories) and a DOE contractor (Lawrence Livermore National Laboratories) regarding their respective overpack corrosion studies, specifically with reference to a potential repository in tuff. The meeting will be held at the Lawrence Livermore Labs in Livermore, California. Observations and judgments about the reliability, adequacy, or quality of the studies will not be communicated at this exchange, nor will any NRC/DOE agreements be made. A summary of the information exchanged will be written and signed by both attendees; this summary will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room and will be sent to the first round affected states and tribal representatives. Any observations, judgements, or opinions which the parties wish to communicate to each other will be exchanged by letters, copies of which will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. - On May 10th at 1 p.m., NRC will meet with DOE to discuss the DOE document management system. The meeting will be held at DOE's Forrestal Bldg., Room 6A092, in Washington, D.C. No pre-meeting documents have been generated. The NRC contact is Phil Altomare on 301/427-4677.
- On May 20-21, from 8 am to 6 pm, in Albuquerque, New Mexico, NRC and DOE will sponsor a Symposium on Groundwater Flow & Transport Modeling for Performance Assessment of Deep Geologic Disposal of Radioactive Waste. The purpose of the symposium is to provide an opportunity to exchange ideas on current and developing performance assessment approaches in the fields of groundwater flow and transport modeling, associated with the geologic disposal of radioactive waste. The symposium will be composed of both invited and contributed papers. Participation will be limited to approximately 100 persons, consisting of HYDROCOIN participants and their invitees; a limited number of observers will be admitted as space allows.
