Requirements Definition

Dear Ms. Mearse:

As discussed by Allen Whiting and Phil Altomare in a January 30, 1991 meeting, not all of the necessary Center and NRC staff have been available to participate in discussions and interviews to effectively develop the Requirements Definition for Version 3.0 of PASS due on March 4, 1991. Additionally, considerable feedback on Version 2.0 is essential prior to defining the next version of PASS, however, due to delays in loading the data, that has not been fully accomplished.

Feedback is being received at the present time from the intense effort to load the RR/REOP data and revisions are being made in Version 2.0 as problems are encountered. It is apparent from the feedback at this time that an additional module needs to be developed for interactive input of changes to the data once it has been loaded in the computer using templates in the current batch process. This change will provide functionality that does not exist now and save significant amounts of time in the ongoing loading of the database by the Center's and the NRC's technical staffs.


