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## MINUTES FROM THE NINTH BIOMOVS COORDINATING GROUP MEETING IN OTTAWA, CANADA, NOVEMBER 17, 1989

### 1. Opening of the meeting

The meeting was opened by Ragnar Boge, chairman of the Coordinating Group. The proposed agenda for the meeting was adopted (Appendix 1).

The Coordinating Group meeting was preceded by the Workshop, November 13-17, in which a number of scenarios, the final BIOMOVS report and ideas regarding BIOMOVS 2 were discussed. The Workshop will be summarised in a forthcoming report, Progress Report No 9.

The participants in the ninth BIOMOVS Workshop are listed in Appendix 2.

### 2. Secretary of the meeting

Kristina Skagius was appointed secretary for the meeting.

### 3. Minutes from the last meeting

The minutes from the last meeting in El Paular, Spain, were approved.

### 4. Decisions on Approach A

The time schedule for the continuation and finalisation of the work (see Appendix 3) was approved.

### 5. Decisions on Approach B

The time schedule for the continuation and finalisation of the work (see Appendix 4) was approved.

It was pointed out that the important dead line for both A and B scenarios is the end of february 1990, which is the last date for the Working Group leaders to submit the scenario conclusions to the members of the Final Report Committee.

### 6. Administrative procedures

No administrative procedures were discussed.

### 7. Technical Reports

Technical Reports for Scenario A1 and B1 will be printed and distributed after the ninth Workshop. Technical Reports for the remaining A and B scenarios will be printed and distributed according to the approved time schedules (Appendix 3 and 4).

### 8. Final Report

The time schedule for the Final report (see Appendix 5) was approved.

## 9. BIOMOVS 2

Ideas concerning BIOMOVS 2 were given by the participants during the Workshop. These ideas will be compiled by the National Institute of Radiation Protection (SSI) in Sweden and further discussed in late April 1990 at a meeting in Paris.

It was suggested to produce a Newsletter where a broader description of BIOMOVS 2 should be given. In addition, motivations for a continuation of the BIOMOVS study should be included. This Newsletter should also be distributed to people outside the BIOMOVS group by the help of all BIOMOVS participants.

## 10. Time schedule

The time schedules are given in Appendix 3, 4 and 5.

## 11. Future meetings

It was agreed upon that the next and last BIOMOVS Workshop will be held in Stockholm, Sweden, October 11-12, 1990. The workshop will be preceded by a Symposium which will be held October 8-10, 1990. The time schedule for the last meeting is given in Appendix 6.

## 12. Other matters

The chairman informed about a symposium on the environmental consequences of hazardous waste disposal which will be held in Stockholm, Sweden in May 1991.

## 13. Closing of the Coordinating Group meeting

The meeting was closed by the chairman who also thanked the AECB and AECL for hosting the ninth BIOMOVS Workshop.
