 My only comment on the DSRM is on #6 under General Comments. I believe the first sentence should read:

NRR release

The staff should develop a process that will ensure that the principles are applied.....

In other words, to delete the possible interpretation that the actual review of information for withholding is a management function. Management should define the process and resolve disagreements but not routinely perform the reviews.

As Mark mentioned, the DSRM will involve significant rewrite of the criteria and I don't think we should get a mindset of rewording the existing seven. Application of the DSRM might cause us to combine or add criteria.
